Application process

8. Applications can be submitted to the UNIDROIT Scholarships, Internship and Research Programme Coordinator, Ms Laura Tikanvaara: <u>l.tikanvaara@unidroit.org</u>.

- 9. Applications must include (submitted together in one pdf document):
 - i. Short cover letter (1-2 pages)
 - ii. Curriculum vitae
 - iii. Reference letters
 - iv. Example of written academic work (for example: thesis, published article or book chapter)

10. Candidates should nominate the 6-9 month period in which they intend to undertake the scholarship in their cover letter.

Timeline

11. Applications are due by 13 September 2024.

12. Short-listing and interviews will be undertaken in late January and early February. The selected recipient should be in a position to begin the scholarship in February or March (April at the latest). Candidates will be informed of the outcome of the selection process by the end of February.
